

Doctrine of Rebirth

Issues which fall within the scope of Christology include the <u>Trinity</u>, which deals with the relationship between <u>God</u>, <u>Jesus</u> and the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, as well as <u>rebirth</u> and the relationship between <u>Jesus</u>, the <u>Holy Spirit</u> and <u>fallen people</u> (p. 163).




The Value of a Person Who Has Realized the Purpose of Creation

Relationship of dual characteristics between God and a fully mature person

Matt. 5:48


"Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect."



The <u>relationship between God and a perfect person</u> resembles the relationship between the <u>dual</u> characteristics. Jesus spoke of this state of perfection, saying "You, therefore, must be <u>perfect</u> as your <u>heavenly Father</u> is <u>perfect</u>." (Matt. 5:48)

Perfect person : divine value

 Thus, we see that a <u>person</u> who has realized the purpose of creation (perfect person) assumes a <u>divine value</u>, comparable to God.

Purpose for which a human being was created



 Let us consider the value of a human being from the perspective of the <u>purpose for which he was created</u>. Each person is God's <u>substantial object partner</u> who manifests a distinctive aspect of <u>God's dual characteristics</u>.

Purpose for which a human being was created




Hence, that person is the <u>only one</u> in the entire universe who can stimulate that <u>distinctive</u> aspect of God's nature to bring Him joy.

Purpose for which a human being was created




Every <u>person</u> who has completed the purpose of creation is thus a <u>unique existence</u> in the cosmos.




 Let us consider the value of a human being based on <u>his relationship with the universe</u>. The universe is the substantial unfolding of the dual characteristics of a human being.



A person's <u>spirit self</u> encapsulates all elements of the <u>spirit world</u> while his <u>physical self</u> encapsulates all elements of the <u>physical world</u> (p. 164).



 A person who has completed the purpose of creation thus encapsulates all the essences of everything in the <u>cosmos</u>. This is why a human being is called a microcosm of the universe (p. 165).



For these reasons, a <u>human being</u> has the value of the entire cosmos.



Jesus and the Person Who Has Realized the Purpose of Creation



2.1 Perfected Adam, Jesus and the Restoration of the Tree of Life




Hence, <u>Adam</u>, had he realized the ideal of perfection symbolized by the tree of life in the Garden of Eden, and <u>Jesus</u>, symbolized by the tree of life in the Book of <u>Revelation</u>, would be identical in the sense of having <u>realized the goal of creation</u>.

2.2 Jesus, Human Beings and the Fulfillment of the Purpose of Creation




 A <u>perfect person</u> has the same divine nature as God. He is unique in all the cosmos. Furthermore, he possesses the value of the cosmos.

2.2 Jesus, Human Beings and the Fulfillment of the Purpose of Creation



There is no greater value than the <u>value of a person</u> who has realized the ideal of creation. This is the <u>value of Jesus</u>, who surely attained the highest imaginable value (p. 166).



 Thus, <u>Jesus</u> is a <u>human being</u> who realized the ideal of creation on the individual level.

2.3 Is Jesus God Himself?

John 14:9-10

He who has seen me has seen the Father


When Philip asked Jesus to show him God, Jesus said, "He who has seen me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show me the Father?' Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father in me?" (John 14:9-10)

2.3 Is Jesus God Himself?

He who has seen me has seen the Father


Based on such biblical verses as this, many Christians have believed that Jesus is God, the Creator (p. 167).



Since <u>Jesus</u> is one with <u>God</u>, he may be understood to be <u>God's second self</u>; but he is <u>not God Himself</u>.




Jesus and Fallen People




1 Dominion over all things and angels

Because <u>Jesus</u> came with the full value of a true person who has completed the purpose of creation, <u>angels</u> and all things were put in his <u>dominion</u> (p. 168).




- **2** No original sin: no Satanic Invasion

- 1 Dominion over all things and angels


3 Jesus thoroughly understood the Will and Heart of God.

4 He also <u>experienced God's Heart</u> as his own reality in daily life.


Fallen person





A fallen person has nothing of the value of a true person who has completed the purpose of creation. Rather, he has fallen to such a lowly status that he looks up to the angels, who were created to be his subordinates.


Fallen person





A fallen person with original sin is stained with the condition through which Satan can attack him.







4.1.1 Jesus and the Holy Spirit and Their Mission to Give Rebirth




Jesus came as the <u>True Father</u> in order to give rebirth to fallen people, transforming them into good children, thoroughly cleansed of original sin. The <u>Holy Spirit</u> came as the <u>True Mother</u> (p. 170).

Logos is Greek for "rational principle" or "the Word."

Because they fell, however, this world became an earthly hell.




This being the case, should not there also have come the <u>True Mother</u> of humankind and the second Eve? The one who has come as the True Mother is the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

4.1.3 Spiritual Rebirth through Jesus and the Holy Spirit




When we believe in <u>Jesus</u> as the Savior through the inspiration of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, we receive the <u>love of the spiritual True Parents</u>, generated through the give and take between Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

4.1.3 Spiritual Rebirth through Jesus and the Holy Spirit




- Through this love, new life is infused into <u>us</u>, and our spirits are reborn as <u>new selves</u>.

4.2 The Trinity





4.2 The Trinity




 God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit thus become one, and this oneness constitutes the Trinity.

Trinities with God and with Satan




If <u>Adam</u> and <u>Eve</u> had not fallen, but had formed this trinity with <u>God</u> and become the <u>True Parents</u> who could multiply <u>good</u> children, their descendants would have also become good husbands and wives with God as the center of their lives.

Each couple would thus have formed a trinity with God.

Trinities with God and with Satan




 Instead, when <u>Adam</u> and <u>Eve</u> fell, they formed a <u>four position foundation with Satan</u> as their center; in other words, they formed a fallen <u>trinity with Satan</u>.

Spiritual and Perfect Trinities




 Jesus and the Holy Spirit in oneness with God could form only a spiritual trinity. They could fulfill only the mission of spiritual True Parents.

Spiritual and Perfect Trinities



<u>Christ must return</u> in the flesh and find his <u>Bride</u>. They will form on the earth a perfect trinity with <u>God</u> and become <u>True Parents</u> both spiritually and physically.

Spiritual and Perfect Trinities



They will give fallen people <u>rebirth both spiritually and physically</u>, removing their original sin and enabling them to build <u>trinities on earth</u> with God as the center.
